- Migration peak in 2015
- Numbers are low since 2016


- CIMADE > the number of migrants sent back has augmented by 34% in 2017
  - OFPRA says that the asylum seekers have gone upto 17,5% in 2017.
- In April 2018, the Home Minister Gérard Collomb estimated the number of illegal migrants to around 300/400.000 in France (**Source: Le Journal du Dimanche**)

# Arrival of Migrants to EU (Recent data)



# Language crisis in Europe ?

- 27 EU members with 24 official languages
- Most of the countries are monolingual
- English bilingualism is becoming a norm and rapidly increasing in Europe

## Language profile of migrants

- Little or no language study has been conducted
- Multilingualism is the norm in the country of origin
- Good basic knowledge of English
- Competency in English increases over time
- Migratory routes expose migrants with new linguistic environments



# Linguistic landscape in refugees centres

## Total of 106 signs

- Primarily informative or directive in nature

## Instruction

- *signs to washing facilities/canteen/social area*
- *in canteen = menu, meal times, cleaning, instructions*
- *in sleeping quarters: instructions re heating, lights, noise, drying*
- *to the sanitary facilities - toilets and washing facilities*

Few monolingual signs in France

Omnipresence of English

Some presence of Arabic

Linguistic sign + Pictogram

Some pictograms without language

## Some general signs

- Visits
- Events
- Transport
- Pick up point for interviews
- Allocation of rooms

# Audioscape and linguistic interaction Fieldwork :

## Porte de la Chapelle & CHUM Ivry

### Porte de la Chapelle

- *Observed in social spaces : recreational area and canteen*
- *Marked by relative silence*
- *Sounds of French from television playing softly in background*
- *Subdued sounds of various languages from the mobile phone interactions between residents and their families (skype/wechat/whatsapp, etc.)*
- *Meal times : sounds of French and English (some Arabic) from canteen staff to the residents*
- *Rather minimal conversation between residents at meal times even if they share the same language (minimal use of vehicular languages for this interaction)*

### CHUM Ivry-sur-Seine

- Several igloos fabricated pour la cantine et pour l'atelier de français
- French is spoken by the social workers or in the offices of Emmaüs who runs the centre.
- Several languages are spoken in the Centre among the migrants : Pashto, Urdu, Dari, Arabic, Rromani, Tigrigina. English remains the lingua franca
- Meal times : French, Arabic, English, Other languages
